REGULATIONS

- The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibit and will not, under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or exhibits of any kind or for any damage done there-to.
- Amplification may be permitted at the discretion of and under the direction of the ground Steward.
- Any person, deemed by a member of the Show executive, to be speaking or acting in an abusive or offensive way, may be disqualified and expelled from the ground.
- Any person, deemed by a member of the Show executive, to be treating an animal in a cruel way, may be disqualified and expelled from the ground.
- The Society reserves the right to test horse exhibits for prohibitive substances.
- Where heights are set out, all animals may be measured on the ground before being allowed to compete.
- District competitors must reside within a 30km radius of Batlow which includes Tumut, Adelong and Tumbarumba.
- Novice competitors have not won a first prize in a similar event at an agricultural show.
- Intermediate horses must not have placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at a Royal Show or won or been runner up at a HOTY show.
- A pony does not exceed 14hh. A Galloway is over 14hh not exceeding 15hh. A hack is over 15hh.
- Unless stated otherwise, a child rider is to be under 17 years of age.
- Events may be split or merged at the discretion of the Judge.
- Height certificates and Registration papers must be carried and shown on request. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- Horses competing in Breed Classes in Ring 3 must be current financial members of the relevant Breed Society. Membership evidence must be presented on request. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- All prizemoney winners will receive a prize card; please take the card to the Show Treasurer at the Pavilion to redeem your prizemoney only AFTER 2pm. Any monies unclaimed on the day in person will be forfeited.
- All winners of sponsored horsefeed will receive a prize card; please take the card to the Announcers Green shed near the grandstand to collect your prize at any time **before 4pm**. Any horsefeed not collected by 4pm will be forfeited.
- Some prize awards may be made in the Rings at the time of being judged.

To help you plan your entries:

Champion and Reserve Champion winners from Ring 1 are not eligible to compete in the second chance Ring 2

Open Hack or Open Show Hunter? You may only compete as either a Hack or a Show Hunter on the day

Brumbies: We are offering showing classes for both Registered and Unregistered Led and Ridden Brumbies. You must nominate on the day whether you are competing in the Open Hack or Show Hunter Classes OR the Brumby Classes.

A Brumby that wins a Champion or Reserve award in Ring 1 is not eligible to compete in the second chance Ring 2

Champion Ridden Brumbies from Rings 1 and 2 are eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Ridden Brumby

The Champion Led Brumby from Ring 3 is eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Led Horse of the Show

Horse Ring Office/Registration will take place in Green office next to Grandstand

PARKING Horse floats to park in designated horse parking area.

Please consider others; parking is limited, so drive through to the farthest available space to avoid blocking others. If requested to move by any steward, you must comply as quickly as possible.

NB. Any competitor found exercising their horse on the golf course will be disqualified.

Any person riding a horse on/within the show grounds MUST be wearing an ASA certified helmet.

TIMETABLE

Judging in Rings 1, 2 and 3 commences at 9 am sharp

At completion of judging in Rings 1, 2 and 3 there will be a 15 minute display by the Australian Military Band Kapooka in the main arena

To be then followed by Major Award judging

All Major Awards will be judged by the 3 judges of the day; announcements will be made. Competitors will be given time to saddle/unsaddle. Judging in this order:

1. HV Smith Encouragement Award

Who is eligible? All competitors under 18 mounted on any horse or pony including lead rein, are invited to compete. This award is all about inclusiveness and encouragement. Each judge will evaluate the horse/rider combination by points. Judging criteria are rider kindness, empathy with horse, suitability of horse for purpose and rider ability. Combinations may be asked for a very simple workout relevant to the horse and rider combination

2. Supreme Champion Led Horse of the Show

NON-JACKET EVENTS FOR TINY TOTS, PONY CLUB AND RECREATIONAL RIDERS. Any competitors who have entered showing and rider classes in the morning in Rings 1, 2 and 3 are welcome to compete in most of the Gymkhana events. Please play fair. Please read the eligibility criteria for classes in each section

Please read these guidelines carefully:

- *No jackets required*
- *Plaiting is optional*
- *Certified safety helmets to be worn by ALL competitors when jumping*
- *ALL exhibitors attending the show today are welcome to compete in the Gymkhana*
- *Please read the clarifications provided for each class. They have been provided as a guideline to help you know what to expect*
- *Our Gymkhana is all about enjoying a day out with your horse. Classes have been carefully created to encourage participation by anyone who loves to ride and play at the same time*
- *TINY TOTS and YOUNG Juniors.... you don't need a pony to compete in our Gymkhana! Bring your own Hobby Horse or Hire one from our Show Stable located near the entrance to the ring. We have 6 Hobby Horses available for hire. Hire fee is \$2 per class, pay Steward in Ring. Please return your Hobby Horse to the Stable after your class,*
- *Hobby Horse competitors must wear a helmet, and be wearing sneakers or boots. No thongs or sandals or bare feet.*
- *Every competitor MUST complete an indemnity form (at Announcer's Box)*

SECTION A: Dress to Impress Classes

Ribbons 1st 2nd 3rd

1. Best Fancy Dress horse and rider/s. Open to all ages. May be ridden independently or on a lead rein. Only horse and rider/s will be judged. Safety and animal welfare considered if multiple riders on one horse. Walk only. The 2024 themes are to be selected from "Gold Mining" or "Picking Apples"
2. Best Presented trail, sporting or recreational horse ridden by an adult (18 years and over). Walk only
3. Best Presented LED pair of PONY CLUB horses, saddled and bridled. Judging based on grooming and the safety and suitability of tack. Handlers must be current members of a Pony Club and wear Pony Club uniform. Plaiting optional. Walk and trot together (in hand).

SECTION B: Tiny Tots and Young Juniors Hobby Horse Specials

Ribbons 1st 2nd 3rd

4. Hobby Horse rider under 7. Walk and trot over ground rails
5. Hobby Horse rider 7 and under 10 years. Walk, trot and/or canter, ground and low rails
6. Hobby Horse Grand National Race rider under 7 years, ground and low rails
7. Hobby Horse Grand National Race, rider 7 and under 10 years, low rails

SECTION C: Easy Equitation Classes for Everyone

No double bridles. No spurs. No show jackets. Smart casual dress or Pony Club Uniform. No jackets. Plaiting optional.
Ribbons 1st 2nd 3rd

Each rider to perform the same pattern individually as described below. The horse itself is not judged. Judging criteria are rider accuracy and empathy with horse.

8. Pony under 14hh
9. Galloway 14hh n.e. 15hh

- (i) Trot a 20 m circle on the left rein
- (ii) Halt. Dismount.
- (iii) Lead horse over low jump A at a trot
- (iv) Remount
- (v) Trot over low jump B
- (vi) Trot or canter a full circle of the ring (clockwise) on the right canter lead
- (vii) Return to judge and halt

10. Hack over 15hh
11. Brumby, any height

SECTION D: Rider Classes for PONY CLUB and RECREATIONAL Riders

Smart casual dress or Pony Club Uniform. No jackets.

Ribbons 1st 2nd 3rd

12. Lead-rein rider under 7 years to be led by an adult (walk and trot).
13. Child rider under 12 years (walk and trot only)
14. District Rider under 12 years
15. Rider 12 years and under 18 years
16. District Rider 12 to 18 years
17. Senior Rider over 18 years
18. Pair of ridden PONY CLUB horses. Riders must be current members of a Pony Club and wear Pony Club uniform. (Walk, trot, canter)
19. Three Riders. Any age and any combination, including a rider on a lead rein (walk and trot)

SECTION E: Obstacle Scurry Challenge Classes

Ribbons 1st, 2nd, 3rd

- *Each horse and rider will navigate a simple short course of everyday obstacles, e.g. ground rails, a tarpaulin, zig zag round marker cones, cavaletti jumps, pick up and carry an object, dismount, lead, mount)*
 - *Every round will be timed. Fastest clean round wins*
 - *No whips. Split reins not to be used to slap a horse. No spurs.*
20. Led horse, handler any age
 21. Assisted rider, any age (to be led or supported by an adult)
 22. Junior Rider under 12 years
 23. Intermediate Rider 12 years and under 18 years
 24. Senior Rider (18 years and over)

SECTION F: Cavaletti Jumping Classes

- *Cavaletti jumps will be placed around the perimeter of the Ring. Competitors enter the Ring, halt, salute the judge, then set off around the course, halt at the end, and walk out of the Ring*
