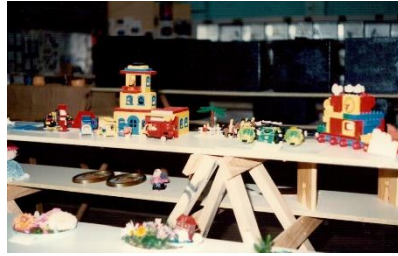

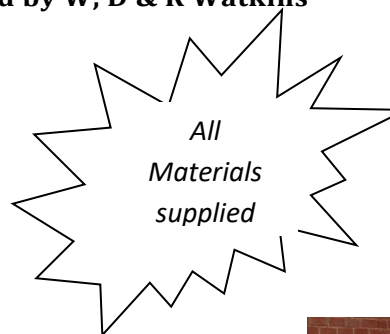

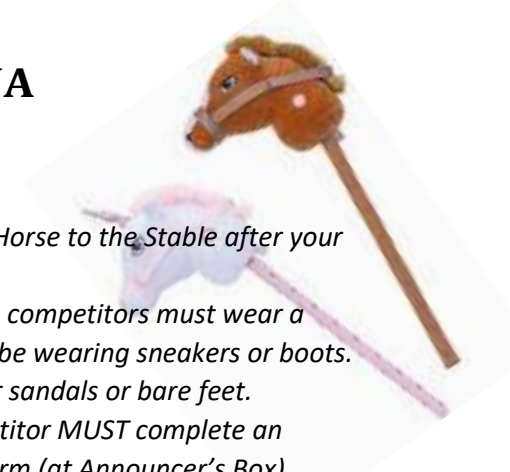
The U BEAUT BONZA GYMKHANA
