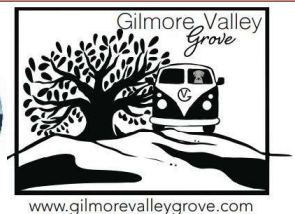

Rings 1, 2, 3 and 4, Ribbons 1st, 2nd, 3rd (unless otherwise stated)
Rosettes or sashes for Supreme Exhibits, Champions and Reserve Champions
Special awards, prizes and their sponsors are noted in the schedule.

PHOTOGRAPHS:

Horse exhibitors are encouraged to take their own photographs at any time of the day at the Forestry Corporation of NSW sponsored area in the showing. Batlow Show Committee members also take photos throughout the day for future promotions.

REGULATIONS

- The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibit and will not, under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or exhibits of any kind or for any damage done-there-to.
- Amplification may be permitted at the discretion of and under the direction of the ground Steward.
- Any person, deemed by a member of the Show executive, to be speaking or acting in an abusive or offensive way, may be disqualified and expelled from the ground.
- Any person, deemed by a member of the Show executive, to be treating an animal in a cruel way, may be disqualified and expelled from the ground.
- The Society reserves the right to test horse exhibits for prohibitive substances.
- Where heights are set out, all animals may be measured on the ground before being allowed to compete.
- District competitors must reside within a 30km radius of Batlow which includes Tumut, Adelong and Tumberumba.
- Novice competitors have not won a first prize in a similar event at an agricultural show.
- Intermediate horses must not have placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at a Royal Show or won or been runner up at a HOTY show.
- A pony does not exceed 14hh. A Galloway is over 14hh not exceeding 15hh. A hack is over 15hh.
- Unless stated otherwise, a child rider is to be under 17 years of age.

REGULATIONS continued

- Events may be split or merged at the discretion of the Judge.
- Height certificates and Registration papers must be carried and shown on request. Failure to do so will result in elimination
- Horses competing in Breed Classes must be current financial members of the relevant Breed Society. Membership evidence must be presented on request. Failure to do so will result in elimination
- All prizemoney winners will receive a prize card; please take the card to the Show Treasurer at the Pavilion to redeem your prizemoney AFTER 2pm. Any monies unclaimed on the day in person will be forfeited.
- All winners of sponsored horsefeed will receive a prize card; please take the card to the Announcers Green shed near the grandstand to collect your prize **before 4pm**. Any horsefeed not collected after 4pm will be forfeited.
- Some prize awards may be made in the Rings at the time of being judged.

To clarify eligibility:

Rings 1 and 2 operate on a Second Chance principle. Competitors who have won a Champion award in the First Chance Ring Classes are not eligible to compete in the same classes in the Second Chance Ring Classes

Hack or Show Hunter? You may only compete as either a Hack or a Show Hunter on the day

Brumby Exhibitor? Yes, you can compete in any suitable classes offered in Rings 1, 2 and 3. See above for ruling on First and Second Chance Rings. You may also compete without restriction in any Ring 4 Brumby classes.

Heavy Horse exhibitor? Yes, you can compete in any suitable classes offered in Rings 1, 2 and 3. See above for ruling on First and Second Chance rings. You may also compete without restriction in any Ring 4 Heavy Horse classes.

Under 18? Yes, you can also compete in the BONZA FUN EVENTS, unless your Horse/Ridder combination has won a Led or Ridden Champion Award in the morning showing classes

Under 18 and competed in Rings 1, 2 and 3 Showing Classes (Led and/or Ridden) in the morning? Yes, you are eligible to compete for the HV Smith Memorial Encouragement Award

Anyone can compete in the Horses in Action Classes if the class suits you and your horse

INDEMNITY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY ALL COMPETITORS

Available at the Green Shed area or available for ***download on the Batlow Show website***

Horse Ring Office/Registration is at the Green Shed next to the Grandstand

PARKING Horse floats to park in designated horse parking area.

Please consider others; parking is limited, so drive through to the farthest available space to avoid blocking others. If requested to move by any steward, you must comply as quickly as possible.

NB. Any competitor found exercising their horse on the golf course will be disqualified.

Any person riding a horse on/within the show grounds MUST be wearing an ASA certified helmet.

For everyone's safety: Horse Trucks and Floats may only enter and exit the showgrounds via Gate 3 on Park Ave

Judging in Rings 1, 2, 3 and 4 commences at 9 am sharp.

FANCY DRESS SPECTACULAR will be judged at 12 noon sharp

MAJOR AWARDS PRESENTATIONS immediately after conclusion of judging in Rings 1, 2 and 3

BONZA FUN EVENTS for under 18's will start immediately following presentation of the HV Smith Award and not before 12 noon

HORSES IN ACTION (Hunter Jumping, Barrel Racing, and Heavy Horses in Harness) will not start before 12 noon

MAJOR AWARDS PRESENTATIONS (at completion of judging in Rings 1, 2 and 3) in the following order:

Who is eligible? All competitors under 18 who have competed (ridden or led) with any horse or pony during THE MORNING SHOWING CLASSES IN RINGS 1, 2 and 3 ONLY. You do not need to have won or even been placed in any class. This award is all about inclusiveness and encouragement. Each judge will have been instructed to keep an eye out for horse/rider combinations who, during the morning showing classes, were polite and kind, displayed good sportsmanship, had empathy with their horse, and deserved to be encouraged in the sport.

Prize: Rosette plus \$25 sponsored by Forestry Corporation of NSW

2. Supreme Champion Led Horse of the Show

Who is eligible? All Led Hacks, Galloways, Show Hunter Hacks, and Ponies who have been awarded a Champion Led on the day (Rings 1, 2 and 3 only)

3. Supreme Champion Show Hunter of the Show
